



Gingerbread-By-Design

Row House Gingerbread House Pattern

Approximate size: 21" wide x 7" deep x 13 ¾" tall

This structure is unusual as it contains interior walls. Treat these walls as you would outside walls.

Walls

Place four **wall pieces (A, B, A and B)** flat on our base so four corners are touching. Apply a bead of frosting along the base and side edges of each piece. Stand-up each wall, connecting pieces to each other at sides. Support with food cans if necessary. Let dry.



Apply a bead of frosting along the base and sides of **pieces A, B and A**. Attach to existing house, forming your middle house. Support with food cans if necessary. Let dry. Repeat again for left house. Houses should now be side-by-side.

Roof

Apply a bead of frosting along all sides of four **center roof pieces E**. Attach pieces E, lining up top edges with house peaks. Hold until set. Apply a bead of frosting along all sides of the two **far left / far right roof pieces F**. Attach to outside walls of house. Hold until set. Let dry.

Bay Windows

Assemble bay windows pieces (**C**) by applying frosting to edge of gingerbread piece first, then attaching the piece to the house, building the bay window out. Attach to outside walls of house. Hold until set. Let dry.

Steps

Cut ½" Styrofoam into graduated lengths for stairs – three each of 3 x 3, 2 x 3 and 1 x 3. Attach these together. Use one of each size to make 1 set of stairs. With frosting, place each set in front of each door for each house. Cover steps as desired.
